- Bring a cycling helmet.

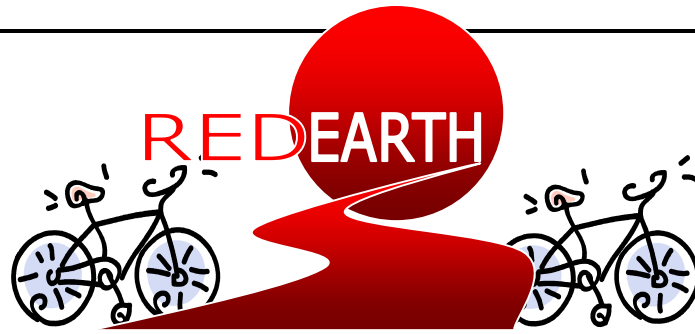
